

## Selected provisions of legal enactments

### **Selected provisions of Act No. 114/1992 Coll., on Nature Conservation and Landscape Protection, as amended:**

Throughout the entire territory of the Šumava National Park, **it is prohibited to:**

1. Camp and light open fires outside the areas reserved by the nature conservation authority
2. Drive in and park a motor vehicle and caravan outside the roads and areas reserved with the consent of the nature conservation authority
3. Hold and organize mass sporting, tourist and other public events outside the areas reserved with the consent of the nature conservation authority
4. Practice water sports outside the areas reserved for that specific purpose by the National park Regulations
5. Mountain climb and paraglide
6. Cycle off the roads and areas reserved by the National Park Regulations
7. Pick plants, with the exception of forest fruit, or capture animals, if not specified otherwise by this act, further protective conditions or in the National Park Regulations
8. Organize scenic flights by means of motorised air transport
9. Enter the national park first zone off road areas, i.e. outside the paths marked with the consent of the nature conservation authority

In the event of a violation of the above prohibitions, then the person is deemed as committing an offence for which a fine of up to **100,000 CZK** may be issued; a legal entity or a person who violates the prohibitions during their business activity can be fined up to **2,000,000 CZK**.

### **Selected provisions of Act No. 289/1995 Coll., on Forests, as amended:**

Each person has the right to enter the forest at their own risk to pick forest fruit and dry brushwood for their own use. During such activity, no damage must be caused in the forest, the forest environment must not be disturbed and the instructions of the lessee and/or their employees must be obeyed.

In the forest **it is forbidden to**

1. Disturb the peace,
2. Enter the stands when logging, manipulation or transportation of wood is taking place,
3. Enter fenced areas or areas marked with a sign prohibiting entry,
4. Cycle, ride a horse, ski or sledge outside forest roads and marked trails,
5. Throw away smouldering objects,
6. Discard waste,
7. Smoke.

In the event of the violation of the above prohibitions, a person is deemed as committing an offence for which a fine may be issued. For an offence in accordance with points 1 to 4, the fine may be up to **5,000 CZK** and for an offence in accordance with points 5-7. the fine issued may be up to **15,000 CZK**.

### **Selected provisions of Act No. 449/2001 Coll., on Game Keeping and Hunting, as amended:**

**It is forbidden to**

1. Allow pets to run loose in the hunting area, i.e. out of the owner's reach.
2. Disturb wild animals in any way, especially when nesting or birthing.

In the event of the violation of the above prohibitions, a person is deemed as committing an offence for which a fine may be issued. For an offence in accordance with point 1, the fine may be up to **30,000 CZK** and for an offence as per point 2, the fine may be up to **10,000 CZK**.
