- the leaves form a basal rosette
- silver and bronze flower

spreading bellflowers

- 20 - 70 cm tall
- violet-blue flowers with widely spreading petals

red campion

- 30 - 90 cm tall
- its leaves and stems are hairy
- rose-red flowers with five petals
